Dear Parent/Person with Parental Responsibility,

The GCSE exams are now completed and your child has now officially left school. Last Friday (24<sup>th</sup> June) we marked the occasion with a Year 11 breakfast and celebratory assembly. This **Wednesday, the 29<sup>th</sup> June**, we have our final **Prom celebration at Lancaster House Hotel**. There are some key information points that I need to share about the Prom event with parents and pupils:

- Pupils should start arriving **from 6.30pm**. There will be photo opportunities outside the hotel for 30 minutes or so.
- Pupils are expected to be in the function room from 7pm to start the celebrations. There will be mocktails, sweets, props and a DJ for entertainment.
- Food is served at 7.30pm.
- **The event ends at 10pm** and pupils should begin to make their way home. Pupils will not be permitted to remain on hotel grounds once the Prom has finished.

It is very important that pupils and parents are aware that high standards of behavior are expected for the evening, and pupils need to follow any instructions given. Any poor behavior/ failure to follow instructions given by school or hotel staff may result in them being ejected from the event.

***It is also worth noting, that as a school-run event for Year 11 pupils, vaping, smoking, alcohol or drug use is prohibited. Anyone caught doing so will be ejected from the event immediately. Any pupil who arrives visibly intoxicated will be refused entry.***

Due to the pandemic, the school Prom has not taken place since 2019 which makes this year's event very special. I am looking forward to a fun evening of celebration; a chance for pupils to relax and enjoy their final school event following an intense exam season.

Finally, a reminder that GCSE results day is on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August. Pupils can pick up their results from the sportshall from 9.30am-12pm.
