That's:

- The year you started school
- The first letter of your first name
- Your last name
- The '@' symbol
- 'carnforthhigh' as one word (don't forget the two 'h's' stuck together!)
- .co.uk

Your **password** was set by you. If you've never set a password, or can't remember it, then click 'Reset password / Resend welcome email:'

You will then need to **re-enter your <u>school</u> email address**, and Unifrog will email you.
