Art Revision Activities

1. Organize Your Portfolio

- Make sure all your coursework is complete, well-presented, and clearly labeled.
- Check that your sketchbooks show development: initial ideas → experimentation → final outcomes.

2. Practise Observational Drawing

- Spend time drawing from real-life objects, not just photos.
- Focus on proportion, shading, and texture—these skills often boost marks in the exam.

3. Annotate Effectively

- Explain your choices: why you used certain materials, techniques, or styles.
- Use art vocabulary (e.g., composition, tone, contrast) to show understanding.

4. Research Artists

- Study at least 2–3 relevant artists for each project.
- Note their techniques, themes, and how they influence your work—this is key for the assessment objectives.

5. Experiment with Media

- Try different materials (paint, collage, digital) to show variety.
- Document your experiments in your sketchbook with photos and notes.
