## Drama Revision Activities

### 1. Character Hot-Seating

- Sit in the “hot seat” as a character from a set text or devised piece.
- Classmates (or you alone with prompts) ask questions about motives, relationships, and emotions.
- Helps deepen understanding of **characterisation** and **context**.

### 2. Design a Stage Plan

- Pick a key scene and sketch a stage layout.
- Include **set pieces**, **lighting positions**, and **actor movements**.
- Annotate why choices suit the mood and themes.

### 3. Create Cue Cards for Key Terms

- Write drama terminology on one side (e.g., proxemics, levels, thrust stage).
- On the other side, write definitions and examples.
- Shuffle and test yourself or use apps like Quizlet.

### 4. Perform a Monologue

- Choose a monologue from your set text.
- Record yourself performing it with attention to **voice**, **movement**, and **gesture**.
- Watch back and note improvements.
- 

### 5. Past Paper Practice with Peer Feedback

- Complete a section of an AQA past paper (e.g., 4-mark or 8-mark questions).
- Swap with a friend or self-mark using the **mark scheme**.
- Focus on using **subject-specific vocabulary** and **justifying choices**.
