## English Literature Revision Activities

### 1. Quote Retrieval & Analysis

- Make a list of key quotes from each text.
- For each quote:
  - Identify the speaker and context.
  - Explain its meaning and effect.
  - Link to themes and character development.
- Use flashcards or apps like Quizlet for quick practice.

### 2. Theme Mind Maps

- Pick a major theme (e.g., power in Macbeth, love in Romeo and Juliet).
- Create a mind map with:
  - Key quotes
  - Characters linked to the theme
  - Contextual points (AO3)
- Color-code for clarity.

### 3. Practice Essay Plans

- Take past paper questions.
- Spend 10–15 minutes planning:
  - Introduction (thesis)
  - 3 main points with evidence
  - Contextual links
- This builds speed and structure for the exam.

### 4. Character Profiles

- For each main character:
  - Summarize personality traits.
  - Add key quotes and their significance.
  - Note how they change throughout the text.
- Include social/historical context where relevant.

### 5. Timed Extract Analysis

- Use an extract from your set text.
- Spend 15 minutes analyzing:
  - Language and structure
  - Themes
  - Context
- Compare your answer to the mark scheme for improvement.
