## Geography Revision Activities

#### 1. Mind Map Challenge

- Topic: Natural Hazards or Urban Issues
- Activity: Create a large mind map with sub-branches for causes, impacts, and management strategies. Use color coding for social, economic, and environmental impacts.
- Why it works: Helps visualize connections and recall case study details.

#### 2. Case Study Flashcards

- **Topic:** Any case study (e.g., Haiti Earthquake, Rio de Janeiro)
- Activity: Make flashcards with:
  - Front: Case study name + key question (e.g., "What were the primary impacts of the Haiti earthquake?")
  - Back: Bullet-point answers.
- Why it works: Quick recall practice for exam-style questions.

#### 3. Exam Question Relay

- Topic: Paper 1 or Paper 2 themes
- Activity: Write 5 past-paper questions on slips of paper. Answer one, then pass to a friend or swap with another question. Time each response (5-8 mins).
- Why it works: Builds exam technique and time management.

#### 4. Map Skills Drill

- **Topic:** Physical landscapes or fieldwork
- Activity: Practice interpreting OS maps:
  - Identify grid references, contour lines, and calculate distances.
  - Sketch a cross-section of a landscape.
- Why it works: Strengthens applied skills often tested in Paper 3.

#### 5. "Explain It to a Friend"

- Topic: Climate Change or Resource Management
- Activity: Pick a concept and explain it in simple terms as if teaching someone with no geography knowledge. Record yourself or do it live.
- Why it works: Teaching reinforces understanding and highlights gaps.
