Maths Revision Activities

1. Topic-Based Question Drills

- Pick one topic (e.g., algebra, ratios, probability).
- Do 10–15 mixed questions from past papers or revision guides.
- Mark your answers and note any mistakes for review.

2. Formula Flashcards

- Write key formulas on cards (e.g., area of a circle, quadratic formula).
- On the back, write an example question.
- Test yourself daily until you can recall them instantly.

3. Timed Exam Practice

- Take a past paper and set the official time limit.
- Focus on **showing full working** and checking answers.
- After finishing, review with the **mark scheme** to understand where marks are awarded.

4. Error Analysis

- Collect questions you got wrong in previous practice.
- Write down:
 - What went wrong
 - The correct method
 - A similar question to try again
- This helps prevent repeated mistakes.

5. Real-Life Maths Challenge

- Apply maths to real-world problems:
 - Calculate discounts and percentages from a shop flyer.
 - Work out travel times using speed-distance-time.
- Makes revision practical and memorable.
