RE Revision Activities

1. Use the Specification as Your Roadmap

- Download the official Eduqas GCSE RE specification.
- Highlight key topics for each component (e.g., Christianity, Islam, Philosophy & Ethics).
- Make a checklist and tick off topics as you revise.

2. Practice Past Papers and Mark Schemes

- Eduqas past papers are essential for understanding question styles.
- Time yourself under exam conditions.
- Compare your answers with the mark scheme to see what examiners expect.

3. Focus on Key Terminology and Quotes

- Learn essential religious terms and their meanings.
- Memorize key scripture references and teachings (e.g., Bible, Qur'an).
- Create flashcards for quick recall.

4. Structure Your Answers

- For 15-mark questions, use **PEEL** (Point, Evidence, Explain, Link).
- Always include religious teachings or quotes to back up your points.
- Practise writing balanced arguments for evaluation questions.

5. Mix Active and Passive Revision

- Active: Mind maps, teaching someone else, writing essay plans.
- Passive: Listening to podcasts, watching revision videos, reading notes.
- Rotate methods to keep revision engaging and effective.
